Nature of Proceedings: STATUS CONFERENCE

The above-entitled cause came on this day for a status conference with all counsel noted on the recorded proceedings.

Counsel argued over Motion's for Equitable Allocation of Costs for Preparation of the Administrative Record. At completion of argument by counsel, the Court ruled that no portion of costs of preparing the Administrative Record should be bore by Glenn Colusa Irrigation District.

The Court found that the costs of \$178,735.42 were an appropriate amount for preparing the Administrative Record. The Court also ruled the Administrative Office of the Courts should pay \$20,000 to be assessed against the costs incurred for preparing the record. Allocation of costs for preparing the Administrative Record is as follows:
