

**Addendum to Order Following Status Conference Held June 10, 2002
State Water Resources Control Board Cases, No. JC 4118**

The Court has considered comments and objections concerning the Order Following Status Conference Held June 10, 2002, and modifies and finalizes the earlier order as follows:

1. The Court will endeavor to post questions or tentative rulings concerning the subjects to be addressed during the series of separate oral arguments, in advance, to the web site maintained for this case as follows (all dates 2002):

For arguments scheduled on July 8, by July 2.

For arguments scheduled on August 5, by July 29.

For arguments scheduled on August 28, 2002, by August 19.

For arguments scheduled on September 23 & 24, by September 16.

For arguments scheduled on October 21 & 22, by October 15.

For arguments scheduled on November 15, by November 8.

2. A question was raised about the schedule for issues concerning "reasonableness" of water use. This is a reference to arguments invoking Art. X, Section 2, of the California Constitution. Arguments concerning the reasonableness of exports from the Delta should be made during session No. 4, September 23 & 24. Arguments concerning reasonableness in the operation or use of water from New Melones Dam should be advanced during session No. 5, October 21 & 22.

3. At the July 8, 2002, hearing, oral argument on Northern California Water Ass'n's Request to File an Amicus Brief, which has been fully briefed, will precede oral argument on the standard of review issues. In the event leave is granted to file the amicus brief, NCWA shall be prepared to participate in the immediately following oral arguments on standard of review.
