

Order Concerning Scheduled Oral Arguments  
Judicial Council Coordination Proceeding No. JC 4118

The orderly progression of these cases requires the Court to schedule more time for oral arguments than previously scheduled. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the oral arguments shall proceed in accordance with the following schedule:

Oral argument on Area-of-origin protections (all) and Reasonableness of Exports

October 21, 22 & 23, 2002, 9 a.m.

Oral argument on San Joaquin River Issues (except for area of origin issues) and other related issues

November 14 & 15, 2002, 9 a.m.

Oral argument on Mokelumne River Settlement (Phase 4) (except for area of origin issues), Implementation EIR, Due Process/Bias Issues, All other remaining issues

Additionally, at 1:30 p.m. on October 23, 2002,, the Court will conduct a brief status conference to determine the issues to be argued on November 14-15 and identify the counsel desiring to participate in those arguments.
