

Sacramento Superior Court CALIFORNIA PENAL CODE (PC) 1170.18, (Proposition 47) Instruction Sheet

Please read the following instructions carefully. Failure to provide the required information to the court may result in the denial or delay of your petition.

<u>Note</u>: Filing multiple petitions on the same case does not result in a faster decision and may, in fact, delay processing of your request. To check the status of a petition you already filed, go to the <u>Criminal Division Index</u> and search by your case number.

Eligible Offenses:	Anyone who has been convicted of the following crimes may file a petition, as long as they meet the other eligibility criteria.

Filing Deadline	A petition can be filed anytime, but no later than November 4, 2022.		

Petition Review Process Proces

Filing Requirements:	 You must file the petition in the court that entered the judgment of conviction. If you were convicted in Sacramento County, you must file your petition with the Sacramento Superior Court. If you were convicted in another county, you must file your petition with the court where judgment was entered.
	At time of filing the petition, you must provide the Court with following:
	• An original petition (Form Number CR-325) and two (2) copies.
	• All documents must be two-hole punched at the top.
	 A self-addressed stamped envelope if you wish to receive a copy of the petition, after it has been ruled upon. Failure to do so will result in a \$25.00 certification charge plus a copy fee of \$.50 per page if a copy is requested at a later date.

Notice Requirements:	 It is your (petitioner's) responsibility to serve a copy of the petition to the District Attorney's Office at the following address: Sacramento County District Attorney's Office 901 G Street Sacramento, CA 95814
Filing Fee Requirements:	There is no requirement to pay a fee to file.
Appearance Requirements:	Your appearance will depend on the type of hearing that will be held.
	 Uncontested petitions do not require your appearance. Hearings are conducted ex parte (in your absence) with a "Rule by Date" as determined by the hearing Judge designated by the Presiding Judge of the Sacramento Court.
	• For contested petitions, you may choose to appear. Your hearing date will be determined by the hearing Judge designated by the Presiding Judge of the Sacramento Court. You will receive notification of the hearing date.

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
