Notice of Unclaimed Funds

November 4, 2020

Pursuant to Government Code § 68084.1, the Superior Court of California, County of Sacramento (Court) hereby issues notice that eligible, unclaimed funds held by the Court, if left unclaimed by January 10, 2021, will be escheated to and become the property of the Court.

Per Government Code § 68084.1 "Except as otherwise provided by law, any money, excluding restitution to victims, that has been deposited with a superior court, or that a superior court is holding in trust for the lawful owner, in a court bank account or in a court trust account in a county treasury, that remains unclaimed for three years shall become the property of the superior court if, after published notice pursuant to this section, the money is not claimed or no verified complaint is filed and served."
