

**ORDER**

**EMERGENCY BAIL SCHEDULE**

(Cal. Rules of Court, Emergency rule 4.)

Pursuant to California Rules of Court, Emergency rule 4, establishing a statewide Emergency Bail Schedule intended to promulgate uniformity in the handling of certain offenses during the state of emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Court orders:

1. Effective April 13, 2020, the following statewide Emergency Bail Schedule applies: (1) to every accused person arrested and in pretrial custody; and (2) to every accused person held in pretrial custody.

2. Under the statewide Emergency Bail Schedule, bail for all misdemeanor and felony offenses is set at \$0, with the exception of only the offenses listed below:

- (1) A serious felony, as defined in Penal Code section 1192.7(c), or a violent felony, as defined in Penal Code section 667.5(c);
- (2) A felony violation of Penal Code section 69;
- (3) A violation of Penal Code section 166(c)(1);

- 1 (4) A violation of Penal Code section 136.1 when punishment is imposed
- 2 under section 136.1(c);
- 3 (5) A violation of Penal Code section 262;
- 4 (6) A violation of Penal Code sections 243(e)(1) or 273.5;
- 5 (7) A violation of Penal Code section 273.6 if the detained person made
- 6 threats to kill or harm, has engaged in violence against, or has gone to the
- 7 residence or workplace of, the protected party;
- 8 (8) A violation of Penal Code section 422 where the offense is punished as a
- 9 felony;
- 10 (9) A violation of Penal Code section 646.9;
- 11 (10) A violation of an offense listed in Penal Code section 290(c);
- 12 (11) A violation of Vehicle Code sections 23152 or 23153;
- 13 (12) A felony violation of Penal Code section 463; and
- 14 (13) A violation of Penal Code section 29800.

15 3. The current countywide bail schedule for the Sacramento Superior Court remains  
16 in effect for all offenses listed above in exceptions (1) through (13) of the Emergency Bail  
17 Schedule, including any count-specific conduct enhancements and any status enhancements.

18 4. Bail for all violations of misdemeanor probation, whether the arrest is with or  
19 without a bench warrant, is set at \$0.

20 5. Bail for all violations of felony probation, parole, post-release community  
21 supervision, or mandatory supervision, shall be set in accord with the statewide Emergency Bail  
22 Schedule, or for the bail amount in the Sacramento Superior Court countywide schedule of bail  
23 for charges of conviction listed above in exceptions (1) through (13), including any  
24 enhancements.


25 6. The Court retains the authority to reduce the amount of bail listed in the its current  
26 countywide bail schedule for offenses in exceptions (1) through (13), or for any offenses not in  
27 conflict with the Emergency Bail Schedule.
