13 **END OF PROBATE FILING HOLIDAY**
14 **RESUMPTION OF SPECIFIED PROBATE PROCEEDINGS**

16 On April 16, 2020, the Court issued an order extending the court closure from April 17, 2020 to
17 May 15, 2020, and implementing renewed emergency relief granted by Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-
18 Sakauye, as Chair of the Judicial Council of California. As part of that order, the Presiding Judge
19 declared April 17, 2020 to May 15, 2020, inclusive, to be holidays for purposes of computing time for
20 filing papers with the court under Code of Civil Procedure Sections 12 and 12(a).

21 The Presiding Judge has now determined that the court is able to resume limited p and motion
22 proceedings through the use of technology and remote appearances. In order to resume these limited
23 probate proceedings on the future starting dates set forth below, it is necessary to end the probate filing
24 holiday earlier than previously declared.

25 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

- 26 1. The Court's April 16, 2020 order, at paragraph 1, is amended to now provide as follows: "April
27 17, 2020 to May 5, 2020, inclusive, are deemed holidays for purposes of computing time for
28 filing papers with the court under Code of Civil Procedure Sections 12 and 12(a)." The "holiday"
period under Code of Civil Procedure Sections 12 and 12(a) previously declared for May 6, 2020
to May 15, 2020, is rescinded relating to probate cases that are or will be handled at the William
R. Ridgeway Family Relations Courthouse.

1 2. Probate judicial officer, at their discretion, may reset matters to be heard on assigned dates and
2 times beginning May 19, 2020. Probate Law and Motion shall be heard in the designated
3 courtroom using only remote appearances. Parties will receive notice of reset hearing dates and
4 related information pertaining to their video remote appearance options.

5 **THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY. THIS ORDER MAY BE AMENDED AS**
6 **CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.**
