**ORDER**

**END OF TRAFFIC FILING HOLIDAY  
RESUMPTION OF TRAFFIC FILINGS**

On April 16, 2020, the Court issued an order extending the court closure from April 17, 2020 to May 15, 2020, and implementing renewed emergency relief granted by the Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, as Chair of the Judicial Council of California. As part of that order, the Presiding Judge deemed April 17, 2020 to May 15, 2020, inclusive, to be holidays for purposes of computing time for filing papers with the court under Code of Civil Procedure Sections 12 and 12(a).

The court is now able to safely and remotely resume the receipt and processing of new traffic filings as of May 11, 2020. Therefore, this Court finds it is appropriate to end the traffic filing holiday earlier than previously declared.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The Court’s April 16, 2020 order, at paragraph 1, is amended to now provide as follows: “April 17, 2020 to May 10, 2020, inclusive are deemed holidays for purposes of computing

1 time for filing papers with the court under Code of Civil Procedure Sections 12 and 12(a). The  
2 “holiday” period under Code of Civil Procedure Sections 12 and 12(a) previously declared for May  
3 11, 2020 to May 15, 2020, is rescinded as it relates to traffic filings.
