

ORDER

END OF JUVENILE COURT FILING HOLIDAY

On May 15, 2020, the Court issued an order extending the court closure from May 16, 2020 to June 12, 2020, and implementing renewed emergency relief granted by the Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, as Chair of the Judicial Council of California. As part of that order, the Presiding Judge declared May 16, 2020 to June 12, 2020, inclusive, to be holidays for purposes of computing time for filing papers with the court under Code of Civil Procedure Sections 12 and 12(a) except as to specified filing types which had been excluded from the filing holiday by separate prior court order.

The Presiding Judge has now determined that as of May 26, 2020, the juvenile court will be able to resume the receipt and processing of all juvenile court filings that were not already permitted under the existing closure order. Thus, it is necessary to end the juvenile filing holiday earlier than previously declared.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The filing holiday provided in the Court's May 15, 2020 order shall end as to all juvenile court filings still subject to the holiday, on May 26, 2020.
