**ORDER**

**IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF**

(Cal. Gov. Code §68115)

Pursuant to the authority granted by order of the Chief Justice of the California Supreme Court as Chairperson of the Judicial Council dated December 29, 2020, and upon the grounds specified in California Government Code section 68115,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED,**

1. This Court may hold sessions anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from January 4, 2021, to February 2, 2021, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1));

2. The Court extends the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than an additional 30 days, applicable only to cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire from December 30, 2020 through January 29, 2021, inclusive. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10).)
