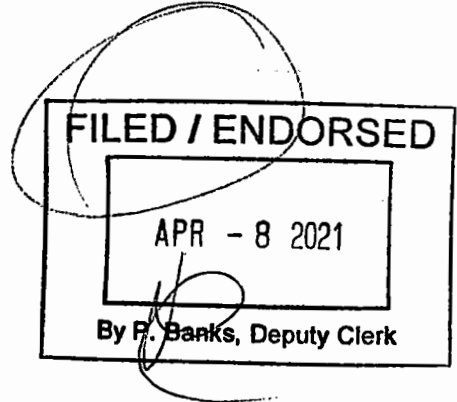

**ORDER
IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF**

(Cal. Gov. Code §68115)

Pursuant to the authority granted by order of the Chief Justice of the California Supreme Court as Chairperson of the Judicial Council dated April 8, 2021, and upon the grounds specified in California Government Code section 68115,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED,

1. The Court extends the time period provided in section 825 of the Penal Code within which a defendant charged with a felony offense must be taken before a magistrate from 48 hours to not more than 7 days, applicable only to cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from April 10, 2021 to May 7, 2021, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(8)).
