

ORDER

RETENTION OF EMERGENCY BAIL SCHEDULE

By Order issued April 13, 2020, this Court adopted and applied the Statewide Emergency Bail Schedule as required under California Rules of Court, Emergency rule 4.

The California Judicial Council has now rescinded Emergency rule 4, effective June 20, 2020. In this respect, the California Judicial Council has directed this Court that upon repeal of the Statewide Emergency Bail Schedule: (1) the countywide bail schedule that was in effect for the County of Sacramento on April 5, 2020, becomes effective, unless this Court adopts a revised bail schedule; and (2) bail is not required to be reset for any person for whom bail was set in accordance with the Emergency Bail Schedule. The Judicial Council has also directed this Court to adopt a bail schedule based on local conditions, including the retention of the Emergency Bail Schedule if it continues to reflect local health needs.

Upon full consideration of the current local health needs, the Court retains the Emergency Bail Schedule as adopted by its order of April 13, 2020.

1. The Emergency Bail Schedule adopted and effective April 13, 2020, continues to apply: (1) to every accused person arrested and in pretrial custody; and (2) to every accused

1 person held in pretrial custody.

2 2. Under the statewide Emergency Bail Schedule, bail for all misdemeanor and
3 felony offenses is set at \$0, with the exception of only the offenses listed below:

4 (1) A serious felony, as defined in Penal Code section 1192.7(c), or a violent
5 felony, as defined in Penal Code section 667.5(c);

6 (2) A felony violation of Penal Code section 69;

7 (3) A violation of Penal Code section 166(c)(1);

8 (4) A violation of Penal Code section 136.1 when punishment is imposed
9 under section 136.1(c);

10 (5) A violation of Penal Code section 262;

11 (6) A violation of Penal Code sections 243(e)(1) or 273.5;

12 (7) A violation of Penal Code section 273.6 if the detained person made
13 threats to kill or harm, has engaged in violence against, or has gone to the
14 residence or workplace of, the protected party;

15 (8) A violation of Penal Code section 422 where the offense is punished as a
16 felony;

17 (9) A violation of Penal Code section 646.9;

18 (10) A violation of an offense listed in Penal Code section 290(c);

19 (11) A violation of Vehicle Code sections 23152 or 23153;

20 (12) A felony violation of Penal Code section 463; and

21 (13) A violation of Penal Code section 29800;

22 (14) A violation of Vehicle Code sections 2800.2.

23 3. The countywide bail schedule for the Sacramento Superior Court that was in effect
24 on April 5, 2020 remains in effect for all offenses listed above in exceptions (1) through (13) of
25 the Emergency Bail Schedule, including any count-specific conduct enhancements and any status
26 enhancements.

27 4. Bail for all violations of misdemeanor probation, whether the arrest is with or
28 without a bench warrant, is set at \$0.

1 5. Bail for all violations of felony probation, parole, post-release community
2 supervision, or mandatory supervision, shall be set in accord with the statewide Emergency Bail
3 Schedule, or for the bail amount in the Sacramento Superior Court countywide schedule of bail
4 for charges of conviction listed above in exceptions (1) through (13), including any
5 enhancements.

6 6. The Court retains the authority to reduce the amount of bail listed in the its current
7 countywide bail schedule for offenses in exceptions (1) through (13), or for any offenses not in
8 conflict with the Emergency Bail Schedule.

9 7. The court may deny bail or set bail as authorized by article I, section 12, or
10 28(f)(3) of the California Constitution.

12 **AMENDED AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.**
