Overview

The William R. Ridgeway Family Relations Courthouse is home to the Sacramento County Superior Court's Family Law, Probate, and Dependency Divisions.

Family Law

The Family Law Division is located on the first floor and responsible for filing cases involving dissolution of marriage, legal separation, paternity, restraining orders, adoption, emancipation and marriage permission.

Family Law records may be obtained in room 102. You must show picture identification to review files.

Probate

The Probate Division is located on the second floor and is responsible for filing cases involving guardianship, conservatorship, trusts, and decedent estates.

Probate records may be obtained in room 214. Depending on when a case was filed, the records may be accessed using the Court's kiosk or by requesting the physical file.

Juvenile Dependency

The Juvenile Dependency Division is located on the third floor and handles cases involving neglected and/or abused children under eighteen years of age. Juvenile Dependency also handles appeals for family law, probate and dependency cases.

Dependency records are confidential but minors, parents, legal guardians, or attorneys may obtain certain records.

Self-Help Center

The Self-Help center provides free legal and procedural assistance to individuals without an attorney in the areas of child and spousal support, divorce/legal separation/annulment, child custody and visitation, paternity, domestic violence, and guardianship

The Self-Help Center also houses the Family Court Resource Referral Program, the Self-Help Computer Room and a Community Resource Room for use by all court customers in need of referrals to community services. All services are provided free of charge.

Children's Waiting Room

A waiting room is available for children ages 1 to 12 years in room 111, on the first floor.
