**AMENDED ORDER: DETENTION
IN YOUTH DETENTION FACILITY
OR COUNTY JAIL AFTER
TRANSFER HEARING
(Welf. & Inst. Code §§ 208, 707.1)**

In any case in which a minor is transferred from the Juvenile Court to a court of criminal jurisdiction pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 707(a), the minor/defendant shall be detained as follows:

1. Transfer to Criminal Court Before the Age of Eighteen: If the minor/defendant is under the age of eighteen years at the time the transfer motion is granted and is not otherwise released on bail or own recognizance, the minor/defendant shall remain in the Youth Detention Facility until the minor's/defendant's eighteenth birthday, pending final disposition by the Criminal Court.

2. Transfer to County Jail: Any minor/defendant who has been detained in the Youth Detention Facility shall be delivered on his/her eighteenth birthday to the custody of the Sacramento County Sheriff without further notice or order of the Court, to be detained thereafter in the Sacramento County Jail pending final disposition by the Criminal Court.¹

3. Arrest After the Age of Eighteen: If an adult is arrested for an offense which is alleged to have been committed when she/he was a minor, the adult shall not be detained in the Youth Detention Facility and shall be delivered to the custody of the Sacramento County Sheriff,

¹ This Court finds the provision of Welfare and Institutions section 707.1(b)(2) regarding a motion for a Criminal Court minor/defendant to remain in Youth Detention Facility after the minor's/defendant's eighteenth birthday to be, as a practical matter, unavailable in Sacramento County because the no-contact, sight and sound separation requirements from persons charged in Juvenile Court, as required by 42 U.S.C. section 5633 and Welfare and Institutions Code section 208, cannot be achieved due to the method of construction of the Youth Detention Facility.
